**RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED SANTA ANA RIVER  
HOMELESS EVICTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the result of recently passed anti-camping ordinances, as well as a perpetual lack of funding for temporary, transitional and affordable housing, over 1000 people now reside along the Santa Ana River Trail, and

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Board of Supervisors have refused to approve expenditure of any of the approximately \$750 Million Dollars earmarked for homeless housing services, and

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Board of Supervisors will begin eviction proceedings on January 22, 2018, leaving the homeless residents exposed to the winter elements with no viable housing alternatives,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Democratic Party of Orange County does hereby oppose any and all such eviction efforts unless and until the Orange County Board of Supervisors appropriates necessary funding to provide adequate housing alternatives for the thousands of Orange County homeless residents.
